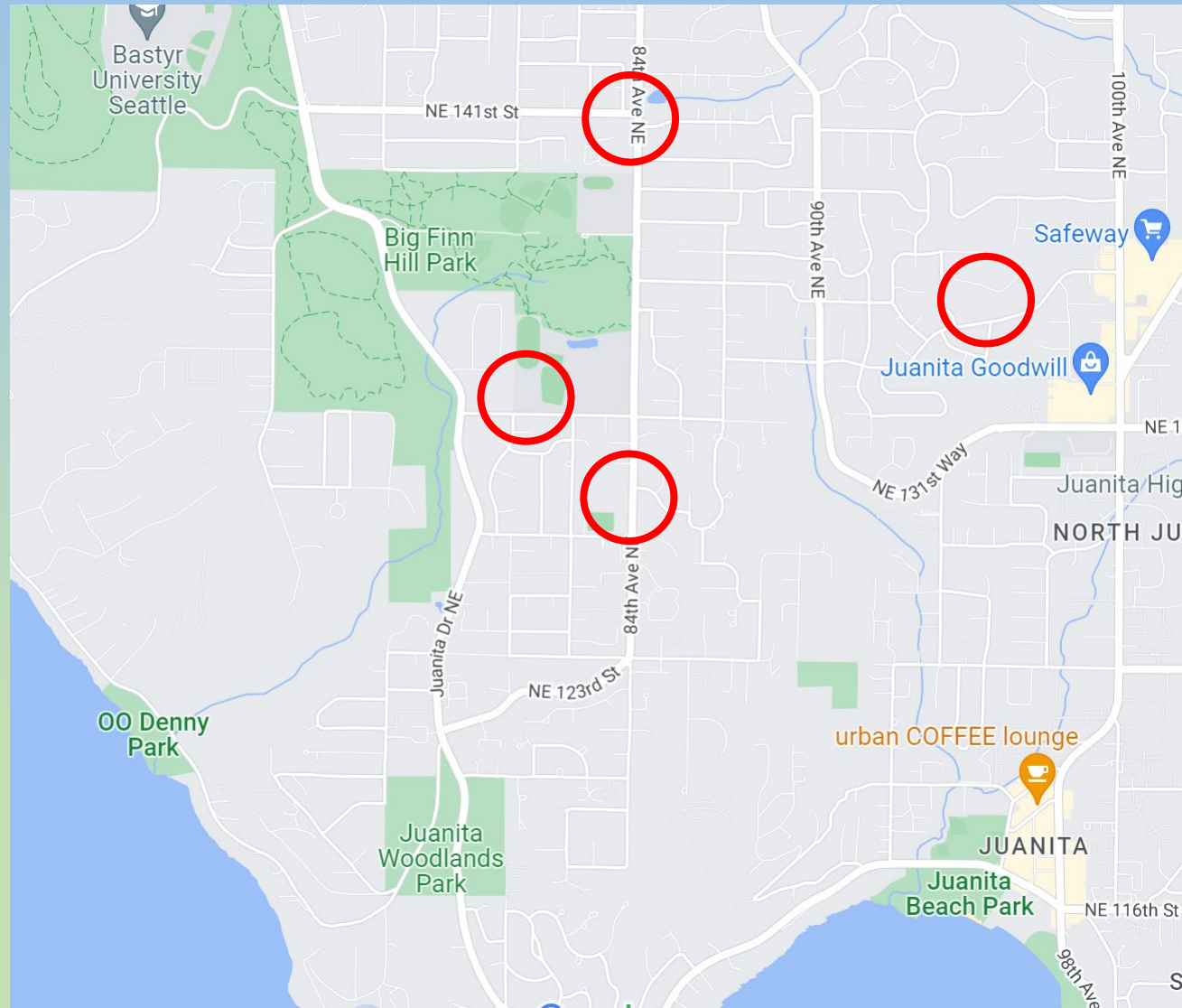

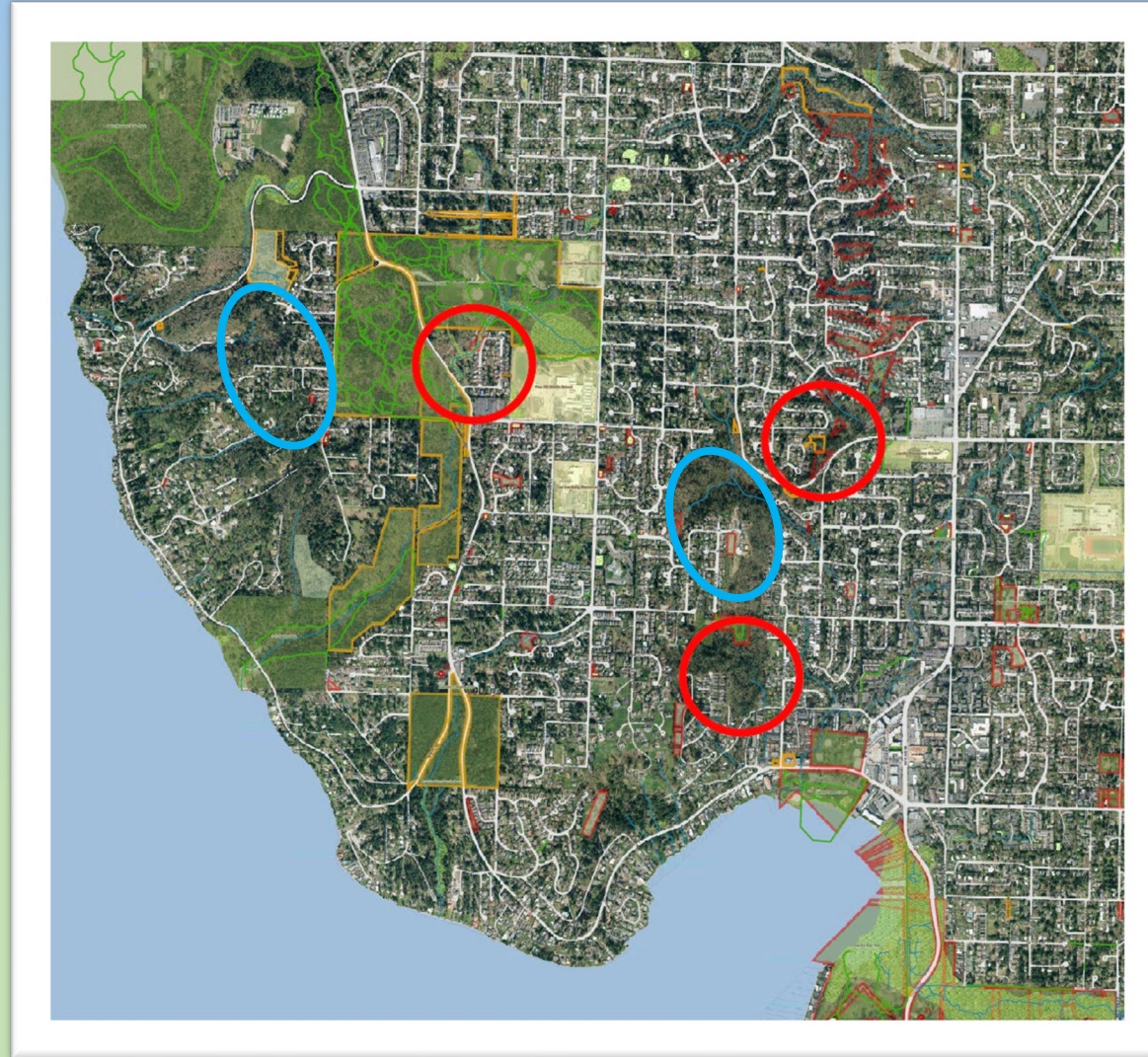
Neighborhood Safety Plan



Kirkland Tree Code

- Citywide tree ordinance revised by Kirkland Council in 2022
- Master Builders have filed administrative appeal with Growth Management Appeals Board
- Decision late in 2023 – settlement possibly sooner
 - Amendments subject to City Council review/approval
- Finn Hill educational effort following resolution of Master Builders' appeal
- Holmes Point Overlay ordinance update needs to be restarted

Finn Hill Green Loop

- Funding with County park levy - \$2.4 million, about \$1 million spent
- Future funding:
 - County Conservation Futures Trust Fund
 - Kirkland park funding ballot measure
- Our own donations
 - Build our own reserve for acquisitions
 - Community campaign to launch later this year
